matter of the most serious practical concern i shall endeavour to show that there was no such double use that in the earlier periods of greek music the scales in use whether called tonoi or harmoniai differed primarily in pitch that the statements of ancient authors about them down to and including aristoxenus agree as closely as there is reason to expect and that the passages on which the opposite view is based all of them drawn from comparatively late writers either do not relate to these ancient scales at all or point to the emergence in post classical times of some new forms or tendencies of musical art the object of the foregoing discussion has been to show in the first place that there was no such distinction in ancient greek music as that which scholars have drawn between modes harmoniai and keys tonoi or tropoi and in the second place that the musical scales denoted by these terms were primarily distinguished by difference of pitch that in fact they were so many keys of the standard scale known in its final form as the perfect system
